Broadband

- 4. High capacity fibre broadband leased lines, aimed pre-dominantly at larger businesses and some SMEs, are available throughout the constituency through products such as Ethernet

- Ethernet node at Towcester exchange
- ADSL at speeds of up to 8Mb: At the remaining eight exchanges in the constituency
